

Analyst Programmer (PRXXX/XX-XX)

The appointee will primarily work on a project of big data analytics in promoting low-carbon cities. Details of the duties include (i) coding, maintaining, and documenting of data analytics; (ii) displaying analytic results in an App; (iii) providing technical assistance to community users; and (iv) installing and evaluating different blockchain platform to offer low-carbon incentives to community users.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's degree in Computer Science or related disciplines, and with two years of work experience in IT related areas preferably. Some knowledge of Java, Swift, and App development (iOS and Android) are preferred. Experience in Linux and Microsoft Windows platforms is preferred. The appointee should be a responsible and good team player, be self-motivated, and detail-oriented. He/She should be flexible and adaptive to changing technologies and priorities.

The appointee will need to work closely with the interdisciplinary team (of Social Science, Science, and Visual Arts). Good communication and interpersonal skills are therefore essential.

The initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract of 12 months. Re-appointment thereafter is subject to performance review and mutual agreement.
