## About the Webinar

Two alumni from Physics Department have been invited to share their study and career development experience with students.

Cheung Sin Hang, Ken obtained a BSc degree in Applied Physics from HKBU in 2009. After that, he worked in various fields, including consultant firm, event management, and interior decoration and a Physics research assistant and eventually a master student. He obtained his M.Phil. in 2019 in organic electronics from HKBU. He is now a Ph.D. candidate in Electrical Engineering in the University of British Columbia, Canada, focusing on the research of thin-film silicon. In this webinar, he will share his work life, and experience of studying abroad.

Carr Ho obtained his BSc in Applied Physics (Physics with Computer Science Concentration) and Ph.D. in Physics at HKBU in 2013 and 2017, respectively. After that, he went to the USA for his postdoctoral research at North Carolina State University. His research focused on organic electronics and transparent solar cells. Last year, he moved to Seattle and joined Meta as an engineer, where he is currently working on image sensor characterization and validation for AR/VR hardware.
